Our church family in Pakistan has grown to nearly 65 gathering last week at Grace Bible Church Ministry Arifwala, Pakistan. They are hungry for the Grace Gospel and the Lord has opened this door for them, by bringing me as a missionary to this country to study under amazing teachers of grace and then giving testimony of His love in the scripture as it is revealed to me and then related through the internet to this group and all that listen on line. We stand amazed at His Grace and provision.

As some of you may know our ministry began Christmas Day of 2008 and each year GBC Pakistan sends a Christmas care package specifically for the encouragement of our ministry children and village children.

In 2009 each child got a lollipop and a My Heart book.

This year, please pray with us in hopes that the Lord opens the door for Carrie and me to be in Pakistan the week before Christmas day to personally put together and pass out these care packages to our ministry children. Your grace gift can bless each child with a Christmas Care Pack.

We now have about 50 children under our watchful care in our colony alone and a total of 147 children in the 6 villages we visit each and every week. We thank God every day for this privilege and opportunity to pour Christ and His words into these children. We have also begun to collaborate with the AWANA ministry in Pakistan in hopes to bring our kids the AWANA program this coming year of 2011.

This Christmas our goal is to give each child some or all of these items:

- Appropriate clothing and/or shoes
- Toiletries, including soap, toothpaste and a toothbrush
- School supplies including notebook, pencils, small box of crayons, and pens
 - Food item market fruit and lollipop
- Lamb of God picture story and coloring books

If you like to become more intimate we can and will send you a picture of one of our ministry children that you and your family can correspond with through our ministry. This would be a blessing for them to know that someone in a far away land cares.
